She works with a variety of data sources: Longitudinal cohort studies (such as the Nurses' Health Studies and the HUNT study), vital statistics registries (including linked Norwegian birth and mortality data), and randomized trials. She's an Associate Professor at Harvard Medical School and the Harvard Chan School of Public Health.
